

Synopsis

This, the fourth and final volume of the series on Market-Garden in September 1944 reveals the final fate of the troops at Oosterbeek and the decision to evacuate all able bodied men in Operation â ^Berlinâ ™ as well as the subsequent Operation â ^Pegasusâ ™ when the Allies tried to return as many beleaguered troops back to Allied lines as possible. Was Arnhem indeed â ^a bridge Too Farâ ™?
