

Roger Stone's and Robert Morrow's new book, "The Clintons' War on Women," is the ultimate Clinton Exposé: A "no holds barred" look at the numerous scandals and criminal behaviors of Hillary and Bill Clinton which have previously been either indelicately hidden, perfunctorily denied or spun into oblivion by them and their sycophantic apologists. This account lays bare all the gory details of how the Clintons have exploited the generally sympathetic and politically correct news media to build a nearly-impenetrable shell around themselves and their enigmatic "Clinton Foundation."
