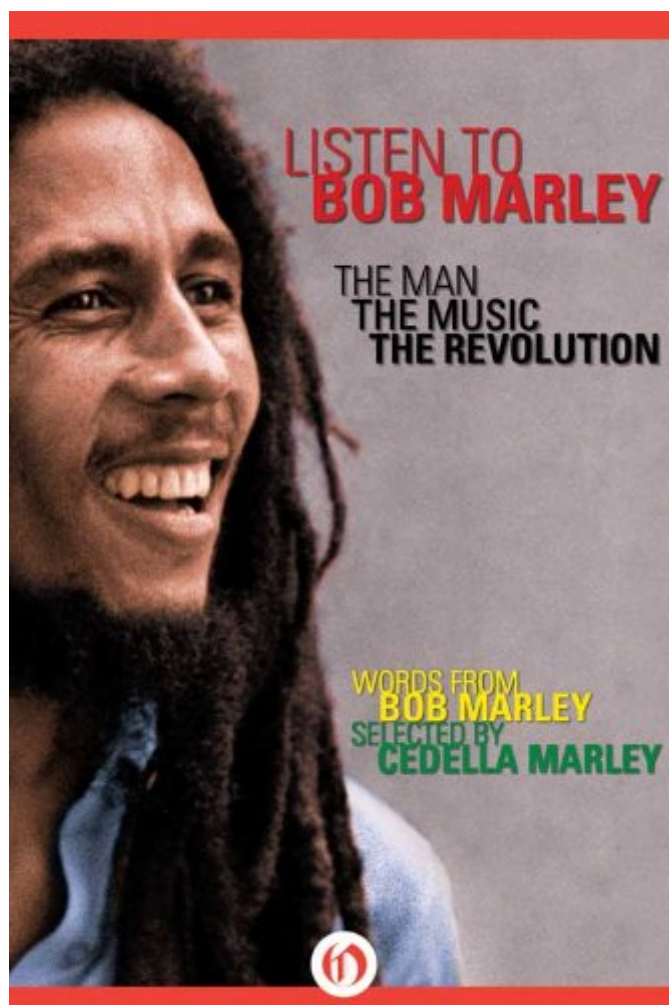

The last 10 pages or so has a bio of Cedella Marley, which to be honest completely threw me off guard.
